Students Requesting a DRA horse: List your classes in priority order. Riders can choose different horses for each class if they'd like. For students requesting a DRA horse: If you fail to show up on the day of the show and do not notify the office, and we have reserved a horse for you, then you will be invoiced for your classes. Specific class assignments will be made considering all student requests and horse capacity. We do the best we can to honor requests, but please check the Class/Horse Assignment List that is emailed out the week before the show for final placements. We can usually place students in 3-6 classes depending on the number of entries.

Students Using their own horse: Write down class name and number, and note that you are using your own horse.

If competing in any jumping classes, you must also register for at least one flat (non-jumping) class. Payment is due on the day of the show.

- *Italic* = Classes that count for year end awards
- *Classes that may be split into two separate classes to accommodate interest and horse use
- **These classes may be combined for placing at shows depending on entries. (Eq Team Jumping and DRA Medal are always run as a combined class.)
- #a, b, or c) = Riders may show at different fence heights, but will be scored and placed as a single class.
- Equitation Over Fences = Rider is judged on position and teamwork with the horse over fences at the height described in the class title. Equitation style courses often include a change of direction, rollbacks, bending lines, halt on course, trot fence, option fence, end fence, etc., but ground poles and cross rail equitation will not have any of those elements.
- Equitation on the Flat = Riders are judged in a group with no jumps on position and teamwork showing at the walk, trot, and canter unless otherwise specified, both ways of the ring.
